

NETFS Applications vs Places Available

August 2006 Entry

The NETFS was heavily oversubscribed in 2006.

There were 239 places available.

There were approximately 100 more applications than places.

August 2007 Entry

There were 264 places available.

There were slightly fewer applicants than places, and all individuals who met the appropriate criteria were placed in NETFS.

August 2008 Entry

There were 300 places available

There were approximately 20 more applications than places.

August 2009 Entry

As the process is a national one, and London is a popular place to work, we expect to be oversubscribed (more applicants than places). It is however, not possible to estimate with any reliability
